New Cardiology Unit

A new, \$2.6 million cardiology unit opened at Harper University Hospital in January 2005. The 14,000-square-foot unit includes 15 patient rooms, including eight private rooms, four semi-private rooms, two observation rooms and one VIP suite. Electronic patient charting stations are built into the wall of every room, allowing physicians and nurses access to real time patient information. State-of-the-art portable telemetry units also provide easy access at patient bedsides. In addition, two nurses will be assigned to care for every patient in the observation rooms and every nurse has received Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) training.


Carotid Artery Stenting

Physicians at Harper University Hospital are training other doctors nationwide in a new, minimally invasive treatment to prevent stroke in patients with carotid artery disease. The new procedure - carotid artery stenting with embolic protection system - promises to give new hope to high-risk patients who might not be candidates for traditional surgery. The key to the new procedure is a tiny blood filter (embolic protection system) that collects plaque that might dislodge from the artery wall and cause a stroke. Harper University Hospital is home to one of only 20 centers in the United States authorized to train physicians in the new technique and the hospital are the only doctors in Michigan qualified to train other doctors in this new procedure.


